ABOUT CAMBRIDGE AND CLARE COLLEGE

Nestled in the historic heart of Cambridge, Clare College is also a short walk from the River Cam, making it the perfect venue.

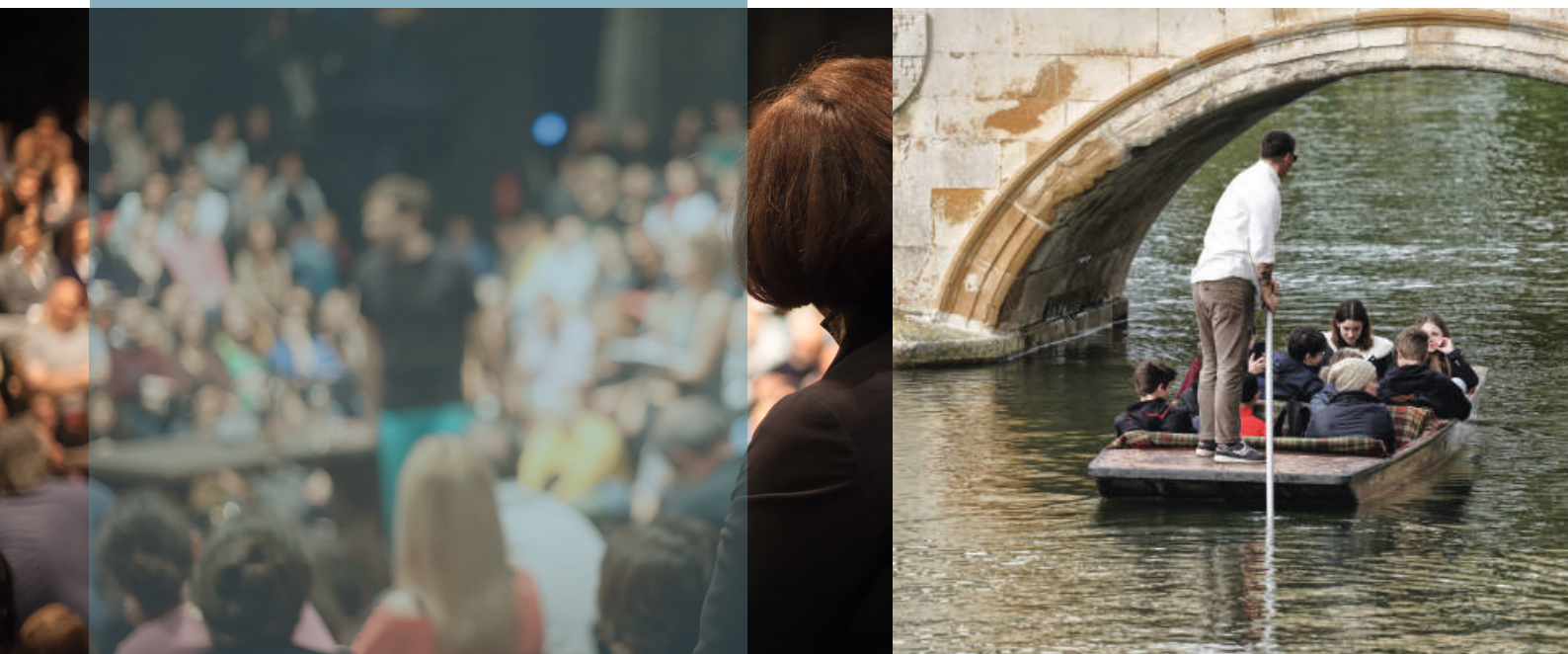
Cambridge city is a beautiful university town with a history stretching back to pre-Roman times. The original permanent human settlement in Cambridge was on Castle Hill - which was built by the Romans.

There was evidence of human activity preceding this, but it was the Romans who created the first recognisable town. Under Danish rule in approx. 875 AD Cambridge grew to be a mid-sized town.

Cambridge University was founded in 1209 and granted a royal charter by Henry III in 1231. It is the second-oldest university in the English-speaking world and the world's fourth-oldest surviving university.

Clare College, the venue for The CAMBRIDGE INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM: Leaders for a Sustainable Future, is the second oldest of Cambridge's thirty-one colleges. It was founded in 1326 and endowed a few years later by Lady Elizabeth de Clare, a granddaughter of King Edward I (1272-1307).

Clare College is ideally located with excellent conference facilities in peaceful, relaxed surroundings. Nestled at the side of Memorial Court, the conference facilities at the Gillespie Centre have received excellent feedback from conference organisers and delegates since opening. Clare College has a first class reputation for food, having an award-winning team of chefs, creating outstanding menus and offering fine dining in both intimate and atmospheric dining rooms.

Cambridge is about fifty miles north of London. Cambridge is well-served by both air, train and bus travel, with direct fast trains from London (45 minutes) and easy connections across the country.

Visitors can arrive at Heathrow, Gatwick or Stansted airports, which are nearby. Participants arriving into London Stansted or London Gatwick enjoy a direct rail service from both airports. Travel from London Heathrow is convenient via Heathrow Express rail and London King's Cross rail service.

There is a taxi rank outside Cambridge Railway Station, with a short journey to Clare College.

Limited car parking is available by prior arrangement. Please contact the symposium office to make the necessary arrangements.
